Chapter visits will include:


1. Presentation to Chapter Membership:

The rest of the Executive Board as well as the General Body Members would like to extend our thanks to Robert Thomas and encourage you to keep up the fantastic work.




DUNSBE Member of the Month: Alpha Bah
